

Advisory on Fake Extension Stamps

The Philippine Embassy in Kuala Lumpur would like to call attention to the rampant incidence of fake validity extensions on Philippine passports including the forging of signatures of signing officers of the Embassy.

A tampered passport may put the person at risk of being prosecuted for an immigration offense by Malaysian authorities. If found liable, the applicants may be imprisoned and their names blacklisted by Malaysian authorities. They shall also be included in the Philippines' passport watch list.

Filipinos are advised that any endorsements on Philippine passports including extensions must be processed **directly** by the Philippine Embassy. Thus, all applicants are advised to have their passport's validity extended **ONLY** at the Consular area of the Philippine Embassy or during official consular mission (www.philembassykl.org.my/main/index.php/consular-services/passport/9-uncategorised/359-schedule-of-mobile-consular-missions-for-2018).
