

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR PAKISTANI, BANGLADESHI AND NIGERIAN NATIONALS

Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Nigerian nationals who are travelling to the Philippines for business and/or tourism purposes are required to have a visa prior to entry in the Philippines. These nationals may apply only at the Philippine Embassy at their country of origin or their country of legal residence.

The abovementioned nationals who have Malaysian Employment Pass, Student Pass, Dependent Pass or Permanent Resident Card may apply at this Embassy. Those who are on temporary visit to Malaysia cannot apply.

The requirements are following:

- 1) Duly accomplished and signed Visa Application Form;
- 2) Original and photocopy of the passport data page and Malaysian visa valid for at least six (6) months;
- 3) Malaysian Company letter (for holders of Employment Pass);
- 4) Malaysian School Certification (for holders of Student Pass);
- 5) Letter of Invitation from the Philippine Company (for business purposes);
- 6) Letter of Invitation from the inviting person in the Philippines supported by a copy of the passport or ID with signature of the inviting person, *if applicable* (for tourism purposes);
- 7) Certificate of No Derogatory Record issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Putrajaya;
- 8) Bank Statements;
- 9) Copy of the two-way/roundtrip air ticket or flight itinerary;
- 10) Copy of the Hotel Booking;
- 11) One (1) recent colored photograph sized (1.77" x 1.37"); and
- 12) Other documentary requirements as may be requested by the Visa Officer upon interview of the applicant and assessment of the application.

Visa Fee : **RM 192.00**
Submission Time : **9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. only**
Processing Period : **10-12 working days**

Note : Visa applicants are requested to come in appropriate attire.

Non-appearing applicants must have their Visa Application Form duly notarized by a Commissioner of Oaths or Notary Public. The representatives who will file and submit the Visa Application Form and the supporting documents must submit a duly notarized authorization letter by the visa applicant and a copy of the representative's Identification Card.
